The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by 1. filed waiver of service of summons of MARY KALISHEVICH (Doc. No. 420), and DONALD KALISHEVICH (Doc No. 420).

- 2. MARY KALISHEVICH & DONALD KALISHEVICH were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-1-0048, Defendants MARY KALISHEVICH & DONALD KALISHEVICH were subject to the Special Master's September 8, 2005 Amended Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 4 and 8 of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 387) ("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of January 10, 2006, for the return of a Consent Order, or the filing of a form Subfile Answer.
 - 4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-1-0048 were never extended.
- 5. Defendants MARY KALISHEVICH & DONALD KALISHEVICH failed to submit a request for consultation, file a subfile answer, or return a signed Consent Order for Subfile ZRB-1-0048 in accordance with the Procedural and Scheduling Order or other applicable scheduling orders.
