- 2. ROBERT C. KEENAN & LANICE M. KEENAN were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-1-0050, Defendants ROBERT C. KEENAN & LANICE M. KEENAN were subject to the Special Master's September 8, 2005 Amended Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 4 and 8 of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 387) ("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of January 10, 2006, for the return of a Consent Order, or the filing of a form Subfile Answer.
- 4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-1-0050 were extended by the Order Granting Motion to Extend Time for Persons Served with a Summons to File Subfile Answers (Doc. No. 442), which extended the deadline to file a subfile answer to 20 days after service of summons and the Amended 2003 Complaint.
