and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by 1. filed waiver of service of summons of GLENN MCDORMAN (Doc. No. 586) and VIRGINIA MCDORMAN (Doc. No. 587).

- 2. GLENN MCDORMAN & VIRGINIA MCDORMAN were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-2-0103, Defendants GLENN MCDORMAN & VIRGINIA MCDORMAN were subject to the Special Master's December 14, 2005 Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 9 and 10 of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 436) ("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established deadlines of March 10, 2006, for the submission of a Request for Consultation, and of April 10, 2006, for the return of a signed Consent Order, or filing of a Subfile Answer.
