# **MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT**

The Plaintiffs United States of America ("United States") and New Mexico ex rel.

State Engineer ("State"), pursuant to Fed. R. Civ P. 55(b)(2), move the Court to enter its order

granting default judgment against the following defendants:

# BRIANNA CLARK & MARCIASubfile No. ZRB-3-0180LUDDEN & SEAN LUDDEN

and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by

the filed waivers of service of summons of SEAN LUDDEN and BRIANNA CLARK (Doc. No.

1484) and filed proof of service of summons on MARCIA LUDDEN (Doc. No. 1732).

2. BRIANNA CLARK & MARCIA LUDDEN & SEAN LUDDEN were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.

3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-3-0180, Defendants BRIANNA CLARK & MARCIA LUDDEN & SEAN LUDDEN were subject to the Special Master's September 27, 2006 Order Granting Joint Motion to Amend Procedural and Scheduling Orders and Establish or Revise Deadlines for Defendants to Return Requests for Consultation and Submit Subfile Answers (Doc. No. 837)("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of February 3, 2008, for the return of a signed Consent Order or submission of a Request for Consultation.

4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-3-0180 were never extended. In addition, the Defendant MARCIA LUDDEN failed to waive service of a summons and, after being served, failed to serve and file an answer as required by the summons and Federal Rule of Civil Procedure 12(a)(1)(A)(i).

5. Defendants BRIANNA CLARK & MARCIA LUDDEN & SEAN LUDDEN are in default for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend in Subfile ZRB-3-0180 within the time limitations imposed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, applicable Procedural and Scheduling Orders, or Orders of the Court extending deadlines, as shown by the Clerk's Certificate of Default filed June 18, 2008 (Doc.No. 1788).

6. In accordance with the *Zuni River Basin Adjudication Hydrographic Survey Report for Sub-area 7*, as amended, the right(s) of BRIANNA CLARK & MARCIA LUDDEN & SEAN LUDDEN to divert and use the public waters of the Zuni River Stream

System, Sub-Area 7, should be as set forth below:
