2. FRONNIE MURRAY & WADE MURRAY were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.

3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-3-0118, Defendants FRONNIE MURRAY & WADE MURRAY were subject to the Special Master's March 7, 2006 Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Area 7 of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 561)("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of August 12, 2006, for the return of a signed Consent Order or the filing of a Subfile Answer.

- 4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-3-0118 were never extended.
- 5.
