ORDER AUTHORIZING WITHDRAWAL OF DECLARATION


THIS MATTER is before the Court on a "Joint Motion to Allow Withdrawal of Declaration of New Mexico Trust Reserved Water Rights (No. 347)." [Doc. 2892].

The Commissioner of Public Lands, the United States of America and the State of New Mexico ex. rel., the State Engineer's Office, entered into a stipulation that the Consent Order approved by the Court on March 28, 2013 [Doc. 2857] resolves all issues among those parties and requested that the Commissioner's September 4, 2010 "Declaration of State of New Mexico Trust Reserved Water Rights" [Doc. 347] be withdrawn from the Court's consideration.

“A party may withdraw a document from consideration by the Court by filing and serving a notice of withdrawal which specifically identifies the document being withdrawn.” D.N.M.LR-Civ. 7.7. “Withdrawal requires consent of all other parties or approval of the Court.” Id.

The parties affected by the stipulation agree to the withdrawal, and the Court otherwise finds good cause to allow withdrawal of the declaration. Accordingly, the Court approves withdrawal of the Declaration
