1. provide the caption and civil action number of this case (No. 01cv00072-MV/LFG) and identify the subfile by the subfile number (ZRB-2-0098);
2. explain your reasons for disagreeing with the Consent Order offered for the subfile by the United States and the State,
3. include a statement that you have made a good faith effort to consult with and resolve the disagreement with the United States and the State; and
4. be properly filed with the Clerk of Court and served on both counsel for the United States and counsel for the State.

Failure to file and serve a Subfile Answer within twenty (20) days of service of this Notice shall be considered grounds for entry of a default order incorporating the terms jointly proposed by the United States and the State.
