**NOTICE OF PUBLIC INFORMATION WORKSHOP**

A Public Information Workshop to provide information about the Zuni River Basin Adjudication and the adjudication process will be held on Wednesday, July 26, 2006, between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. in the cafeteria at Zuni High School on the Zuni Reservation. The High School is located at 71 Route 301N. Signs within the Zuni Pueblo on the Zuni Reservation indicate the direction of the High School.

This workshop was requested by the Special Master, and has been scheduled and planned by various parties in this case, including water rights defendants represented by the Law & Resource Planning Associates, P.C., the State of New Mexico, the United States of America, the Zuni Indian Tribe, and the Navajo Nation. Water rights claimants now have an opportunity to have their adjudication questions answered in an open-house format. Individuals seeking information may attend anytime between 5:30 p.m. and 8:30 p.m. Workshop participants include

professionals who can answer questions about the hydrographic survey, adjudication procedures, and the legal framework for resolving water rights claims. Participants will not, however, provide legal advice. Another session will be planned and scheduled at a future time.

**Please take advantage of this opportunity. Future status conferences which I will conduct periodically for legal and case management matters will not include general information about the adjudication.**
