



## I. WORK PERFORMED

### A. General Case Management

The Court's data manager continues to build the Court's data base which will track all pleadings and will be used to produce a partial final decree for non-federal rights.

### B. Federal and Indian Claims

Pursuant to the April 5, 2004, Procedural and Scheduling Order, the preparation of the United States' water rights claims on behalf of the Zuni Indian Tribe continues.

### C. Non-federal Claims

The adjudication of non-federal water rights claims is ongoing; the latest procedural and scheduling order, for Sub-area 7, was entered March 7. I held a status conference February 9 in Grants and a working session in Albuquerque on various issues April 3.

When it became clear that our regularly scheduled status conferences and working sessions were inadequate to accommodate water rights claimants' general and specific questions about the adjudication and their water rights, I encouraged the parties to hold public information workshops in the Zuni Basin area. I entered a Notice of Public Information Workshop on June 15 which scheduled the first workshop July 26.
