ORDER

When attorneys seek to withdraw from representation, they must furnish the Court either a notice of appointment of substitute counsel or a statement of the client’s intent to appear *pro se* and the client’s address and telephone number. D.N.M.LR-Civ. 83.8(a). Because the attorneys listed above will no longer receive notification of case activity on behalf of their clients, they must furnish

the Court with their clients' names and telephone numbers so that these defendants may be notified of case activity.

IT IS ORDERED, THEREFORE, that no later than February 22, 2008, the attorneys listed above shall file with the Court a statement of their clients' mailing addresses and telephone numbers.
