I, Gary A. Durr, am employed as a Paralegal Specialist with the Department of Justice and have been assigned to work in support of counsel for the United States in the abovecaptioned case.

A. Pursuant to the Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-area 7 of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 561), defendants in the Zuni River Basin Adjudication were sent a service packet that included a proposed Consent Order, Request for Consultation form, Notice of Water Rights Adjudication, a form Answer, and if the defendant had not been served process or had not voluntarily waived

such service, a copy of the Amended 2003 Complaint, a Request for Waiver of Service of Summons, and two copies of a Waiver of Service of Summons with a prepaid return envelope.
