**ZUNI INDIAN TRIBE’S RESPONSE IN OPPOSITION  
TO MOTION TO WITHDRAW GENERAL ENTRIES OF APPEARANCE  
AND FOR LEAVE TO ENTER LIMITED APPEARANCES**

The Zuni Indian Tribe, through undersigned counsel, hereby responds to the *Motion to Withdraw General Entries of Appearance for Members of the Western New Mexico Water Preservation Association and for Leave to Enter Limited Appearances on Behalf of Association Members When Global Issues Arise* (Doc. No. 1763) filed by Law & Resources Planning Associates, P.C. (“LRPA Motion”). The Zuni Indian Tribe opposes the LRPA Motion for all of the reasons set forth in the United States’ *Opposition to Motion to Withdraw and for Leave to Enter Limited Appearances* (Doc. No. 1777). The Zuni Tribe also concurs with the additional points raised in the *State of New Mexico’s Response in Opposition to Motion to Withdraw General Entries of Appearance and For Leave to Enter Limited Appearances* (Doc. No. 1776). While the Zuni Indian Tribe does not object to an appropriately-scoped limited appearance for purposes of addressing

issues of global concern, the Tribe joins the United States and the State of New Mexico in urging the court to deny the LRPA Motion.
