MOTION FOR DEFAULT JUDGMENT

The Plaintiffs United States of America (“United States”) and New Mexico ex rel. State Engineer (“State”), pursuant to Fed. R. Civ P. 55(b)(2), move the Court to enter its order granting default judgment against the following defendant:

GERALDINE STEWART	Subfile No. ZRB-3-0152
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and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendant as shown by the filed waiver of service of summons of GERALDINE STEWART (Doc. No. 749).

2. GERALDINE STEWART was provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.

3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-3-0152, Defendant GERALDINE STEWART was subject to the Special Master's March 7, 2006 *Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Area 7 of the Zuni River Stream System* (Doc. No. 561) ("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established deadlines of June 12, 2006, for the submission of a Request for Consultation, and of August 12, 2006, for the return of a signed Consent Order or filing of a Subfile Answer.

4. These deadlines for Subfile ZRB-3-0152 were extended by the Order Granting Motion to Extend Deadline For Requests For Consultation (Doc. No. 735), which extended the deadline by which defendants must return a Request for Consultation to July 12, 2006 .

5. Defendant GERALDINE STEWART is in default for failure to appear, answer, or otherwise defend in Subfile ZRB-3-0152 within the time limitations imposed by the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, applicable Procedural and Scheduling Orders, or Orders of the Court extending deadlines, as shown by the Clerk's Certificate of Default filed June 18, 2008 (Doc.No. 1788).

6. In accordance with the *Zuni River Basin Adjudication Hydrographic Survey Report for Sub-area 7*, as amended, the right(s) of GERALDINE STEWART to divert and use the public waters of the Zuni River Stream System, Sub-Area 7, should be as set forth below:
