and as grounds therefor Plaintiffs state:

1. The Court has jurisdiction over the above-named defendants as shown by the filed waivers of service of summons of JAMES BRIMER and BOBBY BRIMER (Doc. No. 1145).

- 2. JAMES BRIMER & BOBBY BRIMER were provided the documents listed in the Declaration of Gary A. Durr (Exhibit 1) on the dates indicated.
- 3. With respect to Subfile ZRB-4-0072, Defendants JAMES BRIMER & BOBBY BRIMER were subject to the Special Master's September 28, 2006 Procedural and Scheduling Order for the Adjudication of Water Rights Claims in Sub-Areas 1, 2, and 3 (Excluding Ramah) of the Zuni River Stream System (Doc. No. 838)("Procedural and Scheduling Order"), which established a deadline of January 9, 2007, for the submission of a Request for Consultation or the return of a signed Consent Order.
