## SUBFILE ANSWER

I OBJECT to the description of water rights offered by the United States and the State as contained in the proposed Consent Order for Subfile ZRB-4-0365. I met with Counsel for the plaintiffs on March 21, 2007. The consent order was not amended to accommodate the information, evidence, and concerns I raised at that meeting and detailed in my follow up letter of April 12, 2007 to Mr. Bradley Bridgewater, Counsel for the United States.

I have made a good faith effort towards resolution of my disagreement with the proposed Consent Order by documenting my concerns and evidence in my letter of April 12, 2007 to Mr. Bridgewater.
