Order Granting Summary Judgment

This matter is before the Court upon the April 29, 2013 Unopposed Motion for Summary Judgment filed by the Plaintiffs United States of America ("United States") and New Mexico ex rel. State Engineer ("State") (No. 2878). The Court, being fully advised, finds that the Plaintiffs' motion is well-taken and should be GRANTED. Upon the record, the Court finds:

herein.

- 1. The Court has jurisdiction of the parties and the subject matter
- On October 22, 2012, Plaintiffs filed a Notice that the Consultation
 Period Has Ended for Subfile No. ZRB-3-0171 (No. 2807).

- 3. On October 26, 2012, Defendants SHIRLEY SWEET & MICHAEL SWEET filed a timely Subfile Answer for Subfile No. ZRB-3-0171 (No. 2810). The Defendants' Subfile Answer indicates that they make no claim as to the water right described in the Consent Order offered to them by Plaintiffs, and otherwise specifies no objection to the description of the water right included in said Consent Order.
- 4. The portions of the *Zuni River Basin Adjudication Hydrographic Survey Report for Subarea 7* (January 2006, as amended), prepared by Natural Resources Consulting Engineers, Inc. under contract to the United States, relating to the water rights of SHIRLEY SWEET & MICHAEL SWEET for Subfile No. ZRB-3-0171 have been introduced into the record, are not disputed by the Defendants, and the same are hereby incorporated as the evidentiary basis of the water rights described in this order.
- 5. The description of the water right included in the last Consent Order provided to Defendants SHIRLEY SWEET & MICHAEL SWEET was consistent with the description for Subfile ZRB-3-0171 included in the *Zuni River Basin Hydrographic Survey Report for Subarea 7*.
- 6. The Defendants' Subfile Answer raises no dispute as to any material fact concerning the Plaintiffs' description of the Defendants' water right in the Consent Order offered to Defendants or in the *Zuni River Basin Hydrographic Survey Report for Subarea 7*. Pursuant to NMSA 1978, Sections 72-4-15 through 72-4-19, Plaintiffs are entitled as a matter of law to judgment against the Defendants consistent

with the facts shown in the *Zuni River Basin Hydrographic Survey Report for Subarea* 7. Defendants have indicated that they concur in Plaintiffs' motion.

7. In accordance with the Zuni River Basin Hydrographic Survey

Report for Subarea 7, as amended, the rights of SHIRLEY SWEET & MICHAEL

SWEET to divert and use the public waters of the Zuni River Stream System, Sub-Area

7, should be as set forth below:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SHIRLEY SWEET & MICHAEL SWEET, and his or her successors, representatives, heirs and assigns, are HEREBY ENJOINED from any diversion or use of the waters of the Zuni River Stream System, except in strict accordance with this order or other orders of this Court in this civil action.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the United States mail a copy of this order to the Defendants SHIRLEY SWEET & MICHAEL SWEET.

IT IS SO ORDERED.




