
ORDER SETTING PRETRIAL CONFERENCE

Plaintiffs’ Motion to Set Pre-Trial Conference in these subfile actions is GRANTED. A **Pretrial Conference** will be held by tele-conference on **November 17, 2015, at 1:30 p.m.** The parties will call the Court’s “meet-me” line at **(505) 348-2356** to participate in the Pretrial Conference. It is recommended that a reliable long-distance carrier be used to ensure sound quality. **This line can only accommodate up to five telephone lines, including the Court’s. If the parties anticipate that they will exceed this capacity, they must contact the Court immediately so that alternative arrangements may be made.**

The parties, appearing through counsel or pro se, shall “meet and confer” no later than twenty-one (21) days before the Pretrial Conference. The parties will cooperate in preparing a Joint Status Report and Provisional Discovery Plan (JSR) that follows the sample JSR available

at the Court's web site. The blanks for suggested dates are to be filled in by the parties. Actual dates will be promulgated by order of the Court. The time allowed for discovery is generally 180 days. The Plaintiff is responsible for filing the JSR by **November 9, 2015**.
