ORDER GRANTING MOTIONS FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

THIS MATTER is before the Court on Plaintiff State of New Mexico's November 8, 2005, Motion for Extension of Time to Respond to the Western New Mexico Water Preservation Association's (WNMWWPA's) Motion to Certify Questions to the New Mexico Supreme Court (Docket No. 398), and the November 15, 2005, Stipulated Motion for Extension of Time in Which to Respond to Motion (No. 396) to Certify Question to the New Mexico Supreme Court (No. 399).
