NOTICE OF SECOND STATUS AND SCHEDULING CONFERENCE

Pursuant to Rules 16 and 53 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure, and the Scheduling Order entered March 30, 2001, as amended (Docket Nos. 31, 63, 68), a status and scheduling conference is set for Friday, September 7, 2001, at 10:00 a.m. in the Mimbres Courtroom, 4th Floor, United States District Court, 333 Lomas Blvd. N.W., Albuquerque, New Mexico.

The purpose of this conference is to develop a plan for proceeding when the Court's March 1 Order staying further action in this case is lifted (No. 3). Counsel should be prepared to discuss the following case management items:

1. Scheduling of responsive pleadings to the United States of America's Complaint.
2. Scheduling of responsive pleadings to the Zuni Indian Tribe's April 20, 2001 Motion to Intervene (No. 48).
3. Mechanisms for managing the participation of unrepresented and *pro se* defendants, specifically: how (and whether) the currently-named, non-governmental defendants should be included in

items 2 and 3, above; and whether at this point in the case, it is useful to require these people (particularly unrepresented people) to file *pro forma* Answers.

4. Other matters raised by responses to the United States of America's June 4, 2001 Report (No. 60) and the State of New Mexico el rel. State Engineer's July 6 Proposal for Proceeding Once the Stay in this Case is Lifted (No. 65).
