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ORDER GRANTING MOTION TO ESTABLISH RAMAH SUB-AREA

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This matter is before the Special Master upon the July 11, 2006, Motion to Establish Ramah Sub-Area for Hydrographic Survey and Adjudication Purposes, filed by the Plaintiffs United States of America ("United States") and State of New Mexico ex rel. State Engineer ("State") (Docket No. 757).

The Special Master finds that the motion is well-taken and should be GRANTED.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) that a separate Ramah Sub-area, consisting of Sections 2, 3, 4, and 9 in Township 10N, Range 16W, and Sections 34 and 35 in Township 11N, Range 16W, plus any portion of the Ramah Reservoir outside those sections, is hereby established for purposes of the hydrographic survey and further proceedings to adjudicate the water rights in said Sub-area;

(2) that the United States may file a Hydrographic Survey Report and propose a Procedural and Scheduling Order for Sub-areas 1, 2, and 3, excluding the Ramah Sub-area; and

(3) that a planning and scheduling conference for the purpose of determining the adjudication procedures to be followed with respect to the Ramah Sub-area will be set and announced by the Special Master.
